

Our project's title is **Intercultural intercourse and discussion of health problems (focused on post-war syndrom) with the use of education through outdoor activities and building relationships to the horses.**

**Main themes** for our project are health problems (focused on post-war syndrom) and education through sport and outdoor activities.

We involve **10 youths and 1 group-leader from each program countries (Hungary and Croatia)** in our program.

We **include people with health problems** into our project, we plan to have half of the participants of each groups of countries with health problems.

The **objectives of our project** is to gather young people to share opinion, to discuss project's themes with active participation of young people of different countries and to open intercultural intercourses. Our methods include non-formal learning (education through outdoor activities, mainly activities around horses), some individual work but mainly workshops in groups, role-plays and round-tables. Activities are in the line of the themes, through which we intend to gain more effective outcome.
